

SUSPENSION OF POLICIES

The Board of Education may, upon the vote required for adoption, amendment or repeal and where compelling reasons exists, cause to suspend at any time the operation of a policy herein contained, provided the suspension does not conflict with law, and such suspension shall terminate at the next meeting of the Board in an emergency. An emergency shall be defined for purposes of this policy as any situation or set of circumstances which the Board has reason to believe will close the schools or jeopardize the safety or welfare of the pupils or employees of the district. Any resolution adopted under emergency conditions shall expire automatically at the first public meeting of the Board following the abatement of the emergency unless the Board moves to adopt said resolution in final form.
