VOTER REGISTRATION FOR STUDENTS

The Board of Education believes that getting young people involved in the election process helps to secure the future of democracy by preparing them to be educated, engaged voters who have formed the habit of voting and contributing to civic life early.

In an effort to promote student voter registration, the Board directs the building principal or other designee to offer all students who are at least 16 years old (but will not be 18 years old by the next election) the opportunity to pre-register. These students must be otherwise qualified to register to vote. These pre-registrations will be automatically registered upon reaching the age of eligibility following verification of the person's qualifications and address.

The district will do so by inviting the student to pre-register on their 16th birthday; offering registration materials through homeroom and other required classes at different times during the year; or offering registration materials at a participation in government program. Students who do not wish to pre-register to vote do not have to do so. There will be no penalty (including participation grades or credits) for choosing not to register to vote.
