As you and your families enjoy the last weeks of summer, the Hudson City School District is preparing to begin another school year filled with great promise and possibilities.

We have been working throughout the summer to prepare for the return of our students. This includes cleaning and reorganizing our buildings and classrooms, offering summer programming, hiring new staff, seeking community feedback, and developing new programs.


- This summer, our afterschool program supported 81 students. Federal stimulus money was used to offset the end of grant funding.
- Summer schools were well attended with over 343 students district-wide and all of our other summer offerings gathered a total of 143 students.
- Between breakfasts and lunches we served nearly 15,000 meals.
- Our custodian staff cleaned and waxed 42 hallways, 67 classrooms, and 3 cafeterias.
- We hired over 40 new staff members, including three new associate principals.
- Over 1,000 new Chromebooks enrolled, and 28 new interactive display boards mounted.
- Starting in September, we will offer new classes in Project Lead the Way (PLTW) Engineering, Automotive Repair, and Agricultural Science. Additionally, we will launch a Saturday Academy for parents on October 1.
- Moreover, I have been working with our school community on a new [strategic plan](#). This is a wonderful opportunity to strengthen our relationships and shape the future of our school district.

The Hudson City School District also plans to make several announcements after the start of school. This includes launching a new district-wide campaign and recognition by a national education group. We are so excited to share these!

Education is all about hope for the future. This hope drives our work, improvements, and innovations as a district. It also drives our continuing efforts to build and sustain life-changing learning opportunities for our students.
